RESCISSION OF AMENDED EMERGENCY REGULATIONS AND STAY HOME – STAY SAFE ORDER

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, Governor Abbott issued Executive Order GA-14, which implemented sweeping statewide regulations aimed at preventing the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, County Judge Don Lymbery's Amended Emergency Regulations Stay Home – Stay Safe Order, executed on April 2, 2020, essentially mirrors Executive Order GA-14; and

WHEREAS, on April 17, 2020, in a televised statement, Governor Abbott set forth the framework for a statewide "return to work" plan for the State of Texas that will be implemented incrementally; and

WHEREAS, Governor Abbott's statewide return to work plan and coming executive orders will supersede all local efforts or render them unnecessary.

THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 418.108, ANGELINA COUNTY JUDGE DON LYMBERY ORDERS:

SECTION 1. All Previous Regulations Rescinded. That the Angelina County Amended Emergency Regulations Stay Home – Stay Safe Order executed on April 2, 2020, effective on April 3, 2020, be hereby RESCINDED in its entirety, effective April 24, 2020, at 5:00 p.m.

SECTION 2. Publicity and Filing. That this Rescission of Amended Emergency Regulations Stay Home – Stay Safe Order under Declaration of Local State of Emergency Due to Public Health Emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
