Order of the County Judge

Mandatory Protective Gear (Mask)

Pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, protective gear covering the mouth and nose will be required for all individuals in Jim Hogg County that are at a place other than their home. All persons over the age of (5) are required to wear some form of covering over their nose and mouth, such as a mask, homemade mask, scarf, bandana, or handkerchief, when entering into or inside of any building that is not the home of the individual. Individuals are required to wear a protective gear (mask) when pumping gas. Protective Gear (mask) is NOT required while engaging in outside physical activity or while riding in personal vehicle alone. "Essential" businesses that are open must always require ALL employees to wear masks.

The intent of this Order is to protect the physical health and well-being of Jim Hogg County citizens and to slow the spread of COVID-19 to the maximum extent possible. This order is a proactive measure being taken for the health and safety of the citizens of Jim Hogg County, Texas. A person who violates this order is subject to a fine up to \$500.00 (Class C Misdemeanor).

As County Judge, I hereby deem it necessary and so order that the MANDATORY PROTECTIVE GEAR is hereby ordered to take effect at 12:01AM on April 7, 2020 and remain in effect until further notice or until order is rescinded.
