A DECLARATION OF THE CITY OF LAMPASAS MAYOR, MISTI TALBERT TO EXTEND THE EMERGENCY DISASTER DECLARATION THROUGH 11:59 P.M. MONDAY, APRIL 6, 2020

WHEREAS, the Mayor, <u>Misti Talbert</u> of the City of Lampasas, Texas ordered the City of Lampasas Emergency Disaster Declaration on Monday, March 23, 2020 to end on April 3, 2020; to limit the spread and public health impacts of the COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, Governor Greg Abbott, submitted a letter to the President requesting Major Disaster Declaration, from the Federal Government, and outlined steps taken through Executive Order to limit the spread of the COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2020, President Donald Trump extended the CDC guidelines for personal hygiene, social distancing, and size of gatherings, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it would be beneficial to the Citizens of the City of Lampasas to extend this order through Monday, April 6, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Lampasas will meet in Special Session on Monday, April 6, 2020 to determine if the Order shall be modified or cancelled to prevent and slow down community spread of COVID-19;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Lampasas, <u>Misti Talbert</u> shall extend the Emergency Disaster Declaration (Stay Home, Stay Safe) through 11:59 p.m. Monday, April 6, 2020.
