**WHEREAS**, The Leon County Judge is issuing an amendment to that said order;


**NOW THEREFORE, THE ORDER BE AMENDED TO ADD BY THE JUDGE OF LEON COUNTY, TEXAS:**

**Essential Businesses.**


- Polling Locations shall be open for voting during Early Voting and on Election Day and the shelter in place order will not apply to those traveling to those polling locations to vote.
