

## ORDER NUMBER 6 UNDER DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ISSUED BY MADISON COUNTY JUDGE

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Madison County Judge declared a Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency for a seven (7) day period, stating that extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Madison County, Texas;

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, Madison County Commissioners' Court approved a thirty (30) day extension of the original seven (7) day Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency, extending the Declaration through April 18, 2020, finding that an emergency still exists.

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020, Madison County Commissioners' Court approved a thirty (30) day extension of the Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency, extending the Declaration through May 18, 2020, finding that an emergency still exists.

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2020, Madison County Judge issued an Order Establishing a Curfew which is in effective until rescinded.

NOW THEREFORE, I County Judge for the County of Madison, Pursuant to the Authority vested by the Texas Government Code Chapter 418, hereby finds and orders:

Effective, Wednesday, May 6, 2020 at 5:00 a.m., I hereby rescind the previous Order Establishing Curfew.
