## **City of Plainview Extends Stay-At-Home Directive to Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup>**

In a continued effort to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, the City of Plainview's Mayor Wendell Dunlap extended the Stay-At-Home Directive until Thursday, April 30<sup>th</sup> 11:59 p.m. The Order went into effect on Tuesday, March 31<sup>st</sup> 11:59 p.m. and was originally scheduled to be lifted on Monday April 6<sup>th</sup> 11:59 p.m.

Hale County Judge David Mull and Commissioners will be looking to update the County's order accordingly on Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.

Failure to adhere to the order can result in fines up to \$1000 and/or up to 180 days in jail. Travel permits are not required in the City of Plainview and no curfew is currently enacted except the normal curfew for juveniles under 17. As always, wash your hands, practice social distancing and contact your physician if you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
